Students will gain a foundational understanding of the theories and practices of individuals in each aspect of the criminal justice system. 1. Identify behaviors of criminals and victims.
2. Define the roles of law enforcement, corrections, and criminals within the justice system.
3. Describe the complex relationship between victims, law enforcement, criminals, and corrections.
